 D D

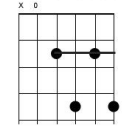
You know I'd give you everything I've got for a little peace of mind

 And curse Sir Walter Raleigh, he was such a stupid git

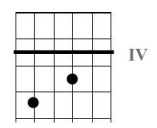
