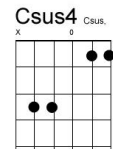
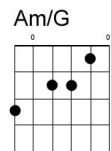
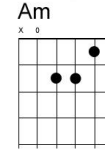

Good bye, Ruby Tuesday. Who could hang a name on you?

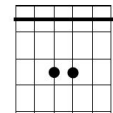
