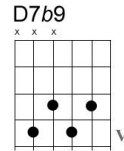
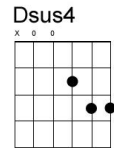


# Single Girl traditional

 Now I'm a married girl, go ragged all the time

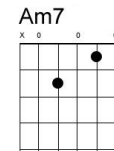

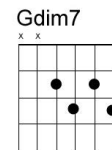
When I was a single girl, had shoes the very best kind
